

Four Audio's Dante Breakout Box

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Four Audio launched its **DBO1, a Dante-enabled breakout box** with 8 analog output channels and allows the user to go from Dante to analogue signals in a 1U box.

Audinate's Dante protocol transports video and audio media over standard IT networks and promotes itself as a "true plug-and-play" digital audio network using standard Internet Protocols such as the AVB.

The DBO1 is operated by connecting to a Dante network and configuring the easy-to-use breakout box via the Dante Controller. The DBO1's smart front panel displays allow easy detection of the network and signal status. The 120dB SNR, 18 dBu output level and integrated Dante redundancy mode means that the DBO1 covers a broad range of applications at very reasonable costs for its end-users.

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
