Klipsch announces the Forte III loudspeaker-- a member of the Klipsch Heritage series featuring "updated cosmetics and the latest advancements in acoustic engineering."



The 3-way speaker combines a 12-winch woofer and a horn-loaded midrange and tweeter, together with a 15-inch rear-mounted passive radiator. Also included are state of the art titanium compression drivers. The midrange horn incorporates a modified Tractrix design with patented Mumps technology, improving coverage and control of the key mid-frequency band.

At 13-inch deep the Forte III solves space issues with a narrow, shallow footprint, while still delivering room-filling sound. Each pair of loudspeakers is grain-matched using wood veneer panels and labeled with sequential serial numbers, ensuring each pair of speakers is a matched set.

The Forte III is available now in American Walnut, Natural Cherry, Black Ash and Distressed Oak.
