Bryston adds native support for Qobuz, the high-resolution (24-bit/up to 192kHz) streaming music service, through a firmware update for the BPD Music Players.

First available in Europe back in 2007, Qobuz enables users to stream uncompressed content from a library of over 40 million tracks representing just about every genre, including jazz and classical music, with millions available in high-resolution 24-bit. Also included is exclusive editorial content along with deep metadata, complete digital booklets, interactive articles, reviews and playlists, all available to Bryston BPD users.

Owners of Bryston BPD products-- from the first BPD-1 to the current BDP-3 player-- can take advantage of Qobuz compatibility by updating the firmware to the latest version, before registering for Qobuz on their website.
