Onkyo launches the BD-SP353-- a slimline Blu-ray player deck complete with DivX Plus HD, AVCHD and high-resolution audio capability together with 1080/24p video and multi-channel audio support.



The player features a number of user-friendly inclusions, including a Quick Start function (reduces disc-loading times), a Continue Mode (bookmarks and resumes video playback after the unit is powered down), Quick (1.5x) and Slow (0.8x) viewing modes and a short skip/replay function. Controls comes through an included full-size remote.

Supported media formats include retail and R/RW-format DVDs (with upscaling to 1080p via HDMI), CDs, MKV video files via USB and AVCHD-encoded DVDs with HD footage shot on video cameras. The front-panel port also supports FLAC and WAV audio fils up to 192kHz/24-bit resolution. The player decodes high-resolution Dolby TrueHD and DTS-HD Master Audio Essential multi-channel audio from Blu-ray discs, or passes them through to AV receivers for decoding via direct bitstream output.

Optical digital audio output allows the sending of Dolby Digital and 5.1-channel DTS formats to legacy AV receivers lacking HDMI input. Meanwhile ethernet connectivity allows the unlocking of interactive and up-to-date content offered by BD-Live, such as film previews, games and live peer-to-peer interaction.
