

Control Home Appliances via HAI Powerline Bus

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HAI now ships a plug-in UPB (Universal Powerline Bus) Appliance Module as part of its Lighting Control line. The device allows you to control different home appliances via a powerline controller.

The Appliance Module can control plug-in devices up to 15 amps, such as fans, coffee makers, televisions, stereos, non-dimmable or fluorescent lamps and more.

The Appliance Module uses Generation II UPB 2-way powerline technology to be remotely controlled by UPB-compatible controllers, including HAI Omni and Lumina family controllers. When configured, the Appliance Module senses the load's local on/off switch (switch trigger) to turn the load on even after it was turned off via UPB control.

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
