

Crestron Brings Speedier TSW Touchscreens

Crestron announces the next generation of TSW touchscreens-- the TSW-560, TSW-760 and TSW 1060, all promising a "bold new level" of performance and security for a broad range of applications.



Available at price points identical, if not lower, to the prior generation, the latest TSW touchscreens carry a state-of-the-art Crestron processor for fast and responsive control and navigation, as well as enterprise-grade security leveraging on the 802.1X, TLS, FIPS-140-2, SSH, and SFTP protocols.

Backlit capacitive buttons on the screen border light up according to user needs, while an ambient light sensor adjust screen brightness and LED backlights according to light levels in the room. Another addition is a built-in PinPoint proximity beacon enabling contextual room booking based on availability, size, location and purpose.

On the mounting side the TSWs have a special latch for easy locking of the touchscreens in place. Power comes via PoE, and the stylings and colour remain identical to previous TSW devices.
