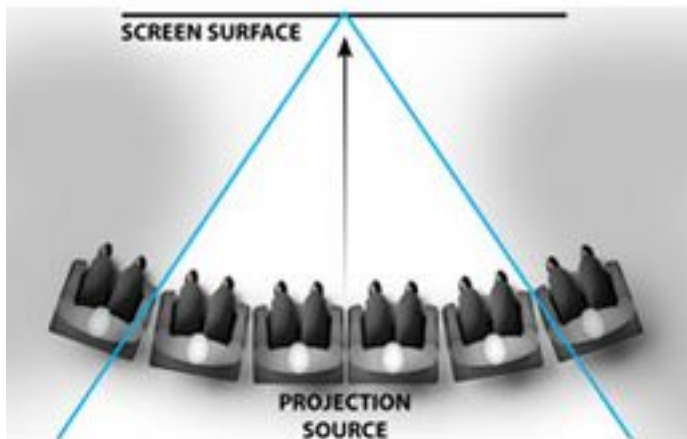


Draper Intros New Screen Selection Tool

When selecting a projection screen surface, everyone knows there are many variables to consider, including screen gain, surface color and screen material. Matching up screen surface capabilities with room conditions can get complicated very quickly, but Draper says it's simplified the process with a free Web-based software tool.

Draper's Projection Screen Surface Selector takes into account variables such as projector brightness, light on the screen, projector location and specs and more to narrow screen surface choices to "good," "better" and "best."

The new screen surface selector was developed using InfoComm standards as a basis for screen selection, and designed to be easy to use by people with basic or advanced AV knowledge.

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
