It has a 333000:1 contrast ration and outputs 2000 lumens of brightness, with DLP technology handling both native 3D and 2D-to-3D conversion.

The company says the the 3D glasses are also redesigned, with black liquid-crystal technology designed to fully concord with the high-speed response from the DLP element.

Further features include a 1.5X zoom lens, integrated 6-segment 3D deep colour DLP colour wheel and both dual HDMI ports and component video input.
