LG announces the launch of a trio of Minibeam series projectors ahead of CES 2016-- the PH550, PW1000 and PW1500, all featuring Bluetooth and wifi connectivity within a slimmer design.



The PH550 features what the company claims "triple wire-free connectivity," since it streams content from mobile devices via wifi mirroring-enabled Screen Share, uses Bluetooth to connect to speakers and runs for up to 2.5 hours on built-in rechargeable battery. Brightness reaches 550 lumens, making it one of the brightest LG battery-powered projectors.

Customers wanting clearer images might be interested in the PF1500, a Minibeam projector featuring 1500 lumens brightness. The PW1000 is similar, if with 1000 lumens brightness.

All the above mentioned Minibeam projectors should be available in European markets from Q1 2016.
