

The Solo Suspended Ceiling Mount System allows installers to mount the Solo low-voltage motorised screen cassette flush with the ceiling grid. Using the grid as the screen reveal eliminates the need for visible flush-mount trim, and allows installers to take advantage of the compact design of the Solo and Solo Pro. The system utilises a standard threaded rod to mount the brackets to the structure above. The cassette remains hidden from view, and the screen descends into the room through a thin opening.

According to SI, Solo is the smallest, most versatile projection screen on the market. The small size and custom colour options make it disappear when surface- or flush-mounted. Installers can mount it to window mullions, making it cover the windows when the screen descends. Using the latest SI ambient light rejection material, Slate, the image retains full clarity and vibrancy even during the middle of the day. Slate is 100% opaque, rendering a perfect image from the latest projectors. When the Slate ascends and the windows are no longer covered, customers can enjoy an unobstructed view of the outdoors.
