Available in a wide range of terminations (including silver-plated VEE 3 RCA plugs, BNC plugs and even 3.5mm mono jacks), Clearway Digital cables use an oxygen-free copper conductor combined with a gas-foamed polyethylene insulation and woven copper shield.

“Right now, the musical experience that very affordable DACs are able to produce is quite extraordinary and to some extent, it produces challenges when it comes to recommending cables to fully exploit their performance,” The Chord Company says. “Many contemporary DACs truly deserve far better cables than they are typically used with. The Clearway Digital is an affordable solution to a truly coherent and involving musical experience. The technology is unique and so is the performance. This is a cable that anybody with a DAC should investigate and listen to.”
