

Covid Adds Two HDMI 2.0 Cables

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Covid announces a pair of HDMI 2.0 cables-- the P-HDFH-DC2 Active Optical cable and the premium HDPR, both offering HDMI HDR support up to 18Gbps together with 4K@60Hz resolution and colour.



The P-HDFH-DC2 Active Optical cable is a plenum-rated, flexible cable with a 5mm bend radius. It is constructed using fibre optics, and as such can be offered in much longer lengths than standard copper HDMI cables. It also has detachable connectors, allowing installers to easily pull in the cable in tight spaces or through conduits.

Once the cable is installed the connectors snap back into place. The cables are available in lengths up to 100m.

Meanwhile the HDPR is the Covid Premium Certified HDMI 2.0 cable. It also carries the HDMI Premium Certified Anti-Counterfeit Labels, and ships complete with Covid T-Grip connectors for a more secure connection, and ships in several lengths.

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
