

The Covid HDMI cable line gets a pair of additions—the locking HDMI cable (HDLK) and right-angle HDMI cable (HD-RA), both designed to tackle common HDMI cabling issues.

The locking HDMI cable features the Ultra Lock System, a simple locking device customers lock into place by pushing up the switch on the connector head. The cables support resolutions up to 4K@60Hz (4K-18G), are triple shielded and are available in lengths up to 3m.

Meanwhile the right-angle HDMI cable is ideal for situations involving limited space. It is also more cost effective compared to purchasing both cable and right angle adapter separately. Construction features copper field shielding, and the cable comes in a 30 AWG gauge size for added flexibility. The right-angle HDMI cables support resolutions up to 2160p@60Hz (4K-10G) and come in lengths up to 3m.

The two cables are shipping now.
